**Debate Arising:**

**Hon Musa Ali Kachako (Takai);** He sympathized with the victims and call on the State Government to assist them with relief materials so as to alleviate their sufferings.

- **Hon.Kabiru Hassan Dashi Deputy (Kiru), Maj Leader** The member urged state government to expediate action by providing aid to the affected people in the respective areas in order to bring succor to them.
- **Hon. Yunusa Haruna Kayyu (Gwarzo)** He lamented that windstorms during rainy season cause a serious damage to the people, particularly in the rural areas. He therefore called on the state Government to assist the victims with relief materials to ease their pains.
- **Hon. Salisu Ibrahim Muhammad (Doguwa)** The member commended the mover and urged the State Government to assist the victims with relief materials so as to reduce their sufferings.
- **Rt. Hon. Isiyaku Ali Danja Minority Leader (Gezawa)** He advised the State Government to direct the State Relief and Emergency, to assess the level the level of damages in the affected areas to assist the victims.

### **RESOLVED**

*It is resolved that the House should direct the joint Committees on Emergency and Relief, Rural Community Development and that of Housing to assess the level of the damages and report back recommendations within one week*
